

Official Rules

These Rules ("Official Rules") detail the requirements, rules, regulations, processes and prizes for the Student Success Virtual Treasure Hunt ("SSF Treasure Hunt") coordinated by SSF organisers. Participants in the Hunt ("Participants") agree to abide by all Official Rules.

1. Preliminary Information.

The SSF Treasure Hunt will begin Monday, November 16, 2020, at 09:00 UK time and end on Sunday November 22 at 17:00 UK time ("Treasure Hunt Period (THP)"). During the THP, teams of Participants will compete against one another to find and/or create specified items ("SSF treasures"), record these items as images or videos, and submit links to these images and videos on the SSF One Drive ("SSF Drive"). Participants should not expose themselves or others to any dangerous or harmful behaviour or activity at any time during this SSF Hunt. Participants agree to abide by any and all applicable local, city, state, country, provincial, national and federal laws of their respective countries and abide by the UK law.

2. Eligibility

The SSF Treasure Hunt is open to all currently registered students at Middlesex University who hold a valid MDX student number. Participants are eligible for the prizes under the following conditions:

- Upon registration, each participant must actively and personally participate in the SSF Hunt;
- Each participant must agree to become a member of a randomly allocated team and agree to team work agreement ("[Team Treaty](#)").

3. How to Enter the SSF Hunt

To register, Participants must go to the Website on those dates that the SSF Hunt registration is made available to students, click on the "Register" link, and follow the instructions to register. Participants must: (a) read and agree to these Official Rules; (b) electronically sign that document and (c) fill out all required (*) registration fields on the Website. The registration link expires on Wednesday 11 November 2020.

4. How to complete the SSF Hunt.

During the SSF Treasure Hunt, Teams compete against one another to find and/or create Items, record these items as original images or videos, and submit these original images and videos ("Entries") on the Website. The SSF Hunt Items can be found on the Website as "Item List", the posting of which will signal the commencement of the Hunt. Participants must submit Entries as indicated on the Website. Teams will be awarded points for legitimate Entries that they successfully photograph or video and submit on the Website. The SSF Treasure Hunt is completed upon that date and time that the Hunt Period ends and the SSF removes the "Item List" from the Website. No Entries will be accepted after this point.

5. Team work requirements

Upon registration, Participants agree to work in a randomly allocated team ("Team") and sign a Team Treaty with their team members.

The team members should ensure that they listen, respect and resolve conflicts in a sensitive manner. No hostile, offensive and rude behaviour is acceptable. Failure to comply with these rules will lead to withdrawal of the team members and cessation of their participation.

6. Submission Requirements

The Entries submitted to the Website may not contain references which are obscene, crude or vulgar, and/or which contain references to crime, references to commercial products unless approved and asked for by the SSF, licence plate numbers, phone numbers, personal addresses (physical or email), derogatory characterisations of any ethnic, racial, sexual or religious groups, references to illegal or inappropriate activity, behaviour or conduct, or any other references that could be considered inappropriate, unsuitable or offensive, as determined by the SSF organisers. Submissions should be original works, and not copied, forged, manipulated or altered, unless Participants are specifically asked to do so for that SSF Item. Submissions of Entries which are incomplete, inaccurate, irregular in any way, or otherwise not in compliance with these Official Rules are void.

7. Scoring and Winning

a. Each SSF Item has a point value. Entries may be disqualified, awarded full or partial point value or bonus points may be added (up to 100% of the item value) as determined in the sole discretion of the SSF judges. Team(s) that submit Entries that are legitimate and accurate, and that accumulate the highest number of aggregate points, as determined by the SSF judges, will win the Grand Prize. The five best submissions will be awarded a £100 Amazon voucher per team.

The prizes are then matched to a Charity of the Winning Team's choice and awarded in the Team and Middlesex University's name.

8. Prizes

1X Grand Prize

£100 Amazon voucher per person. One team will win.

5X Best In Show

£50 Amazon voucher per person, five people will win.

9. Data distribution

By entering the SSF Treasure Hunt, each participant agrees for their name to be used in Middlesex press materials and the SSF website. Upon submitting Entries during the SSF Treasure Hunt, Participants grant the SSF the right to use, reproduce, copy, publish, display, distribute, perform, translate, adapt, modify and otherwise exploit Participants' Content, and to incorporate the Content in other works, including in connection with advertisements, promotions, publicity, and merchandising, in any and all markets and media, whether now known or hereafter developed, throughout the universe in perpetuity, without obtaining Participants' consent, and free and clear of any and all claims for royalties, residuals, or other compensation.

10. Cancellation and Modifications

- a. The SSF reserves the right to disqualify from the Scavenger Hunt any Participant, at any time, at its sole discretion if the SSF believes a person has violated these Official Rules. Any attempt to deliberately damage the Website or operation of the SSF Hunt is unlawful and subject to legal action by the SSF.
- b. If, for technical reasons or other reasons beyond the control of the SSF (including but not limited to tampering or computer virus infection), the SSF Treasure Hunt is not capable of running as originally planned, the SSF reserves the right to cancel, modify or suspend the SSF Treasure Hunt or any element thereof without liability.
- c. The SSF may prohibit any Participant or potential Participant from participating in the SSF Treasure Hunt, if such Participant or potential Participant shows a disregard for these Official Rules; acts with an intent to annoy, abuse, threaten, or harass any other Participant, the SSF, or the SSF's agents or representatives; or behaves in any other disruptive manner (as determined by the SSF in its sole discretion). The SSF reserves the right to modify these Official Rules for clarification purposes without materially affecting the terms and conditions of the SSF Hunt.
